To that end we have arranged that the **Project Vote Smart** (www.votesmart.org/) bus visit this year's Wayne County Fair. The Vote Smart bus is outfitted with the latest electronic equipment, including satellite hook-up.

Project Vote Smart keeps comprehensive records on the performance of all elected officials. It also maintains up-to-date tracking of candidate positions, including their past voting records if they have held office or are currently holding office.

The bus will be at the Wayne County Fairgrounds on Thursday,

September 11th; it will be located near building 25. Network members will be on hand to assist with a tour of the bus and to explain the importance of Project Vote Smart.

It should be pointed out that Thursday September 11th is senior day at the Fair, meaning seniors are admitted without charge to the fairgrounds. That's also the day the demolition derby takes place.
